RESOLUTION TO AMEND THE ZONING RESOLUTION OF DICKSON COUNTY TO ESTABLISH HEAVY AND LIGHT INDUSTRIAL DISTRICTS.

This Resolution is to amend the Zoning Resolution of Dickson County to establish Heavy and Light Industrial Districts. The **M-1** Heavy Industrial District, is intended to provide areas in which the principal use of land is for manufacturing, processing, assembling, fabrication of materials and warehousing or storage, requiring good accessibility to major rail, water or highway transportation routes. The **M-2** Light Industrial District is intended to provide space for low level objectionable influences. All operations to be carried on within completely enclosed buildings which might affect neighboring properties.

RESOLUTION TO AMEND THE ZONING RESOLUTION OF DICKSON COUNTY TO ESTABLISH ZONING FOR OUTDOOR FIREARMS TRAINING FACILITIES AND RELATED ACTIVITIES WITHIN THE COUNTY.

This Resolution is to amend the Zoning Resolution of Dickson County to establish zoning for Outdoor Firearms Training Facilities and related activities within the county. The location must be on a county road, state or federal highway for a distance of at least One Hundred (100) feet. Outdoor Firearms Training Facilities and related activities, excluding Skeet shooting. The development, operation and maintenance of indoor ranges and firearm training facilities shall be in conformance with the most current Range Manual as published by the National Rifle Association (NRA).
